- 1<sup>st</sup> SX undulator in tunnel
- Test insertion and calibration of magnets
- Beginning injector tests and RF commissioning
- 1<sup>st</sup> electrons in few months

- Problems with cryomodules re: transport, bellows, ripped off in vac – largely falls to Fermi and Jefferson to figure this out.

Run 18:

- Potentially March/Apr 2020; first light Fall 2020
